Quiltrick #25: If you quilt on your domestic machine and don't like to wear gloves, try using a product called fingertip grip or "Take Hold" from an office supply store. It's inexpensive, easy to use, helps your fingers grip the fabric and won't mark the surface of your masterpiece.
