Quiltrick #37: Wool appliqué is fun and easy. To make it even easier, iron a piece of fusible interfacing to the back of your wool. Shapes are sew much easier to cut out <u>and</u> it makes the wool less likely to fray. A win-win!

We are excited! We have two wool patterns to introduce this month. "Fall Woolies" and "Holiday Woolies" are wool candle mat patterns which can also serve as mug rugs. They join "Spring Woolies" in our pattern line up and have been flying off the shelves at our last few shows.

In a moment of diversion, I also designed my first knitting pattern, Grace Gloves, for all you quilters who, like me, also knit. It's a pattern for cabled fingerless gloves – so fun!
