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Quiltricks Peepers Keeper

Supplies needed:

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
One inch of 3/4" velcro 1/8 yard focus fabric 1/8 yard lining 1/8 yard batting 1-1/2 yards Coordinating 1/4" double fold bias tape (or make your own from a 2-1/4" wide *bias-cut strip of fabric*) Optional: 1 yard coordinating cording for strap and 2 grommets

Cutting instructions:

Cut focus fabric, lining and batting 3 3/4" x 15 1/2"

Sewing instructions:

- Sew a piece of velcro hook to the center of lining about 1/2" from one short end. 1)
- 2) Put the focus, batting and lining together as you would a quilt (right sides facing out with the batting sandwiched in the middle) and quilt if desired.
- 3) Starting 2" from the top, round the top (velcro) edge on both sides with your scissors to make the flap. (see template above)
- 4) Using your binding, bind the opposite short straight end. Sew velcro loop to the center of the right side (not the lining) of your quilt sandwich about 1/4" from the short bound edge.
- 6) Fold the bound edge (lining side in) towards the flap end so that the bound end is 6 1/2" from the fold.
- 7) Starting at the bottom corner, turn under one end of the binding, bind up one side, across round flap and down the other side, turning under the second end of the binding to finish.
- 5) OPTIONAL: If you want to add a strap, attach a small grommet 1/2 inch from both sides and 2 inches from the rounded top. Lace your cording strap through each grommet hole and tie knots on each end to secure.



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
